

# Sauk Trail Tour

US 12 Heritage Trail.

We are taking the **West Michigan Pike** tour.

Tentatively, we will start our adventure in Benton Harbor/St. Joe area. Then on to Union Pier, Lakeside, New Buffalo, Three Oaks and Buchanan.

Stop at a couple small museums.

Stop at several old ethnic resorts, some still used. (African, Jewish, Greek, Swedish Baptist) if available.

The **Sauk Trail** was originally a Native American trail running through what are present-day Illinois, Indiana and Michigan in the United States.

In 1820 Henry Schoolcraft, then at present-day Michigan City, Indiana, described the trail, as a "plain horse path, which is considerably traveled by traders, hunters, and others..." and said that a stranger could not follow it without the services of a guide because of the numerous side trails.
