Gather around a fire for a Great Lakes tradition of Scandinavian immigrants over 100 years. Whitefish is and boiled with potatoes, onions and seasonings in a large kettle.

The highlight is the “boil over”. Kerosene is thrown onto the fire sending flames skyward. This flash of heat causes water in kettle to boil over the sides, taking with it oil drawn out of the fish leaving a healthy fish meal.



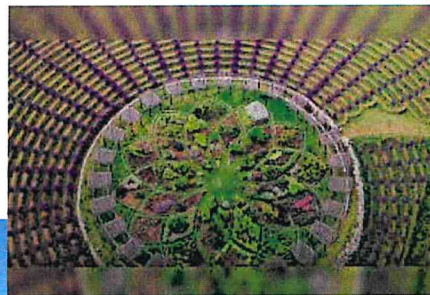
Enjoy lemonade, homemade coleslaw, garlic toast, herb-seasoned butter & cherry pie and ice cream.

Enjoy a walk through Lavender Labyrinth & Herb Garden. The labyrinth is an ancient spiral pattern, is a spiritual journey & symbolic of one’s path in life. Herbs are used as meditation, relaxation and spiritual tools. Unlike a maze, it’s a continuous circuit and you can’t get lost.



An arbor towers above the stone circle and surrounds the herb garden. Designed with the principles of sacred geometry, the 12-point pattern defines 36 beds filled with dozens of herbal varieties. Have you ever smelled the breeze after it brushed a bed of basil? Walk the paths, absorb the essences and experience the serenity of this unique garden.
