3 floors of artifacts, photos, fossils, 1928 carousel and more.

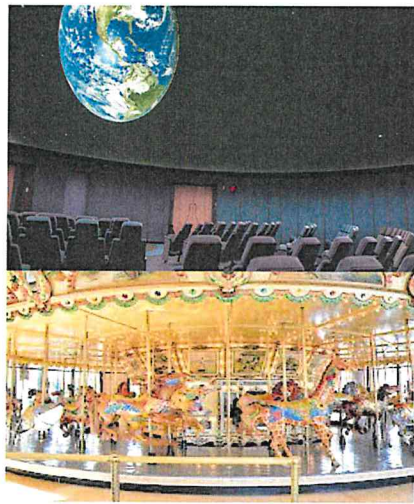
Eat at the Café at any time. Offers snacks and drinks.

The Sistine Chapel is rectangular brick building with 6 arched windows on each of 2 main walls and barrel-vaulted ceiling. The exterior is unadorned, but interior is decorated by many Florentine Renaissance masters. Painted from 1481 to 1483. Michelangelo completed the ceiling painting in 1512. Located in Vatican City, Rome.
