CHARLESTON, SC, SAVANNAH, GA, AMELIA ISLAND & ST. AUGUSTINE, FL

8 Days - 7 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** Depart from home and travel to your overnight stop where lodging has been arranged for you (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2** After breakfast, check out and travel to **Charleston, SC** where you will meet your guide for a **Historic Charleston Tour**. Charleston is one of the most beautiful and historic cities in the South and it features stately homes with lovely gardens, magnificent public buildings, and majestic churches. After the tour, check into your hotel and prepare for a delicious **dinner** at one of Charleston's popular restaurants.
- Day 3** Enjoy breakfast, then depart for a visit to the **Magnolia Plantation** where you will have a **tour of the home and nature tram tour of the gardens**. After your visit, depart for Savannah, GA. Upon arrival, spend time at **Savannah's River Street District** where you can browse in the unique shops and grab lunch on your own. Check in to your hotel before enjoying **dinner** in the area and a wonderful show at the **Savannah Theatre**.
- Day 4** After breakfast, check out and depart for the **Savannah's Visitor Center** where you will meet your guide for a **2-hour tour** of one of the largest restored National Historic Landmark Districts in the nation. Enjoy a delicious Southern **family-style lunch at Paula Deen's The Lady & Sons Restaurant**. Later this afternoon, depart for Florida where you will check into your hotel in the Jacksonville area and freshen up for **dinner**.
- Day 5** Once again, enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then it's off for a **Amelia Island**. As you travel north through Fort George Island, a stop will be made at **Kingsley Plantation**. The plantation house is the oldest still standing in the state, and the remains of the slave quarters are a rare remnant from Antebellum American life. You've traveled from the present to colonial, now step into the Victorian Era with a **tour of Amelia Island** and the former seaport village of Fernandina Beach. There will be time to enjoy lunch on your own here, then stop at **American Beach** at the southern end of the island. In 1935, the Afro-American Life Insurance Company purchased 200 acres, which was eventually transformed into a glorious oceanfront haven for African Americans during the Jim Crow era of segregation. **Dinner** will once again be arranged this evening at a local restaurant.
- Day 6** - After a delicious breakfast at your hotel, depart for historic **St. Augustine**, one of the oldest continually occupied European settlements in the United States. Meet your guide for a **tour of the city** to include a perimeter tour of **Castillo De San Marcos**. There will be some free time on St. George's Street and in the **Spanish Quarter** for lunch and shopping. No visit to this area would be complete without a visit to the famous **Ponce de Leon's "Fountain of Youth"** where you can even drink from the original well thought to bring immortality. **Dinner** has been arranged for the group in the area, then return to your hotel
- Day 7** Following breakfast, check out and depart for your overnight stop for lodging (*pack an overnight bag*); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 8** Following breakfast, check out and prepare for your departure home with fond memories of your trip down south to **Charleston, Savannah, Amelia Island & Jacksonville**.
