PHILADELPHIA, PA & CAPE MAY, NJ

Plus Hershey & Gettysburg, PA

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 An early morning departure has you traveling east into Pennsylvania. Arrive in Central Pennsylvania where overnight lodging and dinner have been arranged. Please pack an overnight bag as luggage handling is not included.
- Day 2 Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then check out and depart for Hershey the Sweetest Place on Earth for a visit to Hershey's Chocolate World Visitor Center. You will learn about the chocolate making process on the Chocolate Tour Ride through a simulated chocolate factory. You may grab lunch on your own in the food court and visit the gift shop for the opportunity to purchase Hershey chocolates and souvenirs. Later, travel to Valley Forge for a guided riding tour of Valley Forge National Park. Retrace the steps of the nation's first president, George Washington, and the Continental Army with stops at Washington's Headquarters and Muhlenberg's Brigade. A dinner stop on your own will be made at nearby King of Prussia Mall with some time for shopping before continuing to Philadelphia ... the City of Brother Love where lodging has been arranged.
- Day 3 Following breakfast, you will meet your guide for a 3-hour historic tour Philadelphia. Founded and laid out by William Penn, the city was the second largest, but most prominent of the early English colonies. Some of the sites you will see include Independence Hall, Old City Hall, Liberty Bell Center and much more After the tour, head for Reading Terminal Market where you can have lunch on your own at one of the diverse eateries and shop at the various vendors at this famous indoor farmer's market which was established in 1893. This afternoon you will visit the Museum of the American Revolution where immersive exhibitions and priceless artifacts trace the evolution of the colonies from the earliest days of unrest through a legendary war and the improbable victory that led to a new nation. Included are General Washington's Headquarters Tent, a two-story replica of the Liberty Tree, a replica of an 18th-century privateer ship and much more. Dinner will be arranged for the group this evening, and for those who wish, a visit to a nearby Rivers Casino is planned where you can try your luck at the games of chance.
- Day 4 After breakfast, check out and travel to southern New Jersey on the way to Cape May. A stop will be made in the Towne of Historic Smithville where you can stroll along the cobblestone paths of this recreated Colonial village and imagine yourself back in the 18th Century. Explore the multitude of rustic shops and attractions at your own pace before continuing to Cape May where you will spend some free time visiting the shops at the Washington Street Mall. Later in the afternoon you will check into the Grand Hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner is included at the hotel this evening.
- Day 5 Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then depart on a narrated 2-hour dolphin watch sightseeing cruise around the coast. Experience the sights of the inland waterway, including the Cape May Canal, wildlife sanctuaries, commercial fishing fleets and the U.S. Coast Guard Station in Cape May Harbor; you may even see some dolphins. After the cruise, depart for the visit the Physick Estate for a tour of this 1879 lavishly restored mansion which features collections of toys, clothing and artifacts of the rich and famous from the American Victorian Era. After your visit, depart on a trolley tour of the Historic District. Your guide will point out highlights of the gingerbread-trimmed Victorian architecture that has earned Cape May its designation as a National Historic Landmark City and relate tales of Cape May's history as a Victorian seaside resort. You will also visit the Carriage House Exhibit. Return to your hotel to freshen up before continuing to the nearby seashore resort of Wildwood for another delicious dinner and free time on the famous Wildwood Boardwalk.
- Day 6 After an early breakfast at the hotel, check out and travel to **Historic Gettysburg**. Upon arrival at Gettysburg National Military Park Visitors Center, you will have time for lunch on your own in the Saloon, then meet your guide for a narrated tour of the Gettysburg Battlefield. The tour outlines the history of the famous battle as you wind your way through the battlefield featuring 1,328 monuments, memorials, markers, and plaques that commemorate and memorialize the men who fought and died during the Battle of Gettysburg. After the tour, return to the Visitors Center to see the film "A New Birth of Freedom," narrated by Morgan Freeman. View the sound-and-light show on the largest oil painting in North America—the Battle of Gettysburg Cyclorama. Longer than a football field and as tall as a four-story building, this stunning oil painting in-the-round of Pickett's Charge was created in the late 1880s. You can also visit the Museum of the American Civil War featuring interactive exhibits located throughout the 12 galleries,. After your visit, dinner will be provided at a local restaurant, then continue to your overnight stop in Central Pennsylvania.. *Please pack an overnight bag as luggage handling is not included.*
- Day 7 Following breakfast, check out and depart for home taking with you lasting memories of your visit to historic cities in **Pennsylvania and New Jersey**.
