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NEW ENGLAND Coastal Summer Escape

Featuring Martha's Vineyard, Nantucket Island, & Newport, RI

8 Days - 7 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** A morning departure from Michigan has you traveling towards Cape Cod, MA. Arrive at your overnight hotel to check in (*pack an overnight bag*) and prepare for dinner on your own in the area.
- Day 2** Enjoy a continental breakfast, then check out and continue traveling to Cape Cod. The Cape extends 70 miles into the sea and is home to both natural beauty and quaint colonial villages. Arrive at the **Margaritaville Resort** to check in for a four-night stay. This evening's **dinner is buffet-style at the hotel**.
- Day 3** Following breakfast at the resort, your local guide will meet you at the resort to depart on a full day of touring which will take you along historic **Route 6A** (*the Old King's Highway*), a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history, past hundreds of historic structures which characterize its early development. View the Eastham Windmill and a Cape Cod Lighthouse as you travel to the **Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center** for a visit. You will be surrounded by sand dunes and the ocean as you approach "Land's End" at the tip of Cape Cod, **Provincetown**, which was formerly known as the "Province Lands" when the Pilgrims landed here before deciding to settle across the Bay in Plymouth. Provincetown has a rich history which combines a love of the sea and the arts. Walk along the waterfront and the narrow main streets; enjoy your free time exploring the shops, galleries and restaurants that make Provincetown so unique. Enjoy lunch on your own. This afternoon you will enjoy an amazing **3-hour Whale Watching excursion** as you travel into the natural habitat of a diverse marine environment, including birds from all over the Atlantic, and fish which use these shallow waters to feed. Spot the various whales (*Humpback, Minke, and Fin*) going about their daily business. An onboard naturalist will introduce you to everything you see and answer any of your questions. (*You may opt to stay on dry land for a 1-hour Dune Tour that takes you through the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore. Your guide will point out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art.*) **Dinner** is included before returning to your resort for a leisurely evening.
- Day 4** Enjoy breakfast at the resort, then meet your local guide to depart for the Hy-Line Docks for ticketing of the 9:00 am high-speed ferry to the island of **Martha's Vineyard**, which was brought to prominence in the 19th century by the whaling industry, during which ships were sent around the world to hunt whales for their oil and blubber. From 1941 through 1945, Martha's Vineyard was used by the Army, Navy, and Air Force for training missions. In 1974, Steven Spielberg filmed the movie, *Jaws*, on Man the island. Upon arrival you will board a local bus for a **sightseeing tour**. As you pass through Vineyard Haven you will learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders. There will be free time for lunch on your own and shopping in the historic whaling town of Edgartown. Then, visit Oak Bluffs; you may choose to stroll through "Cottage City" with its brightly painted cottages and decorative "gingerbread" trim. Return to the mainland via the 3:35 pm ferry. Dinner is on your own this evening; your guide will offer suggestions.

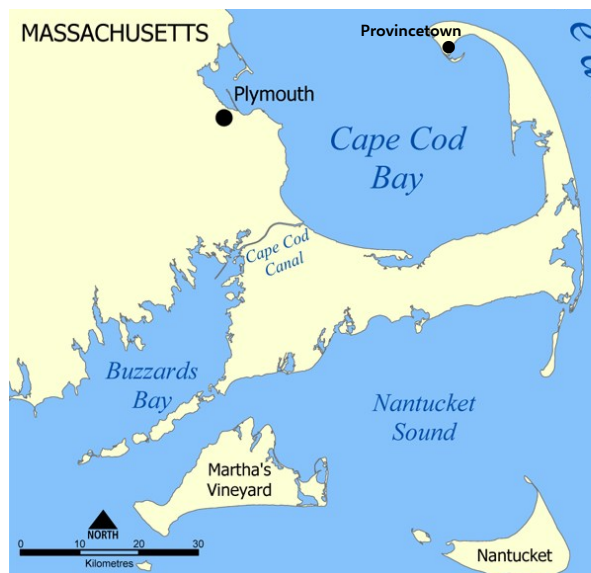


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TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION

Cancellation protection is encouraged for medical emergencies that may occur. The **Enhanced option must be paid within 14 days** from the day the first deposit for the trip is paid to the organization and/or group leader. There is an additional Enhanced upgrade - **Cancel for Any Reason**. Cancellation must be made no later than 48 hours prior to your scheduled departure, conditions, limitations, and exclusions do apply. These plans are only valid for trips booked through White Star Tours. - Day 5** After breakfast at the resort, you will travel to America's first resort town of **Newport, RI**. A comfort stop will be made at the Newport Transportation Center. Your local guide will meet you to depart on a **narrated tour of Newport's historic buildings and restored homes** which covers over 150 points of interest. Enjoy the rugged beauty of Ten-Mile Ocean Drive and the fabulous mansions along tree-lined Bellevue Avenue. Arrive in the historic downtown oceanfront area for lunch on your own and free time to shop in the antique stores, art galleries, and specialty shops. This afternoon you will set sail on the enclosed **Coastal Queen** for a 75-minute Harbor Cruise with picture-perfect views of Newport and close-up views of lighthouses, grand estates, and much more. Admission is included on a self-guided tour of the Breakers Mansion, the grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt Family's social and financial preeminence in turn-of-the-century America. Dinner is included in Newport, followed by return to your resort for a relaxing evening.
- Day 6** Following breakfast at your resort, meet your local guide to depart for the Hy-Line Docks for ticketing of the 9:30 am high-speed ferry to stunning **Nantucket Island**. Upon arrival on Nantucket Island, you will enjoy free time to visit the shops, galleries, and museums and have lunch on your own. In the afternoon you will enjoy a **tour of the Island**; learn about the history of the Island which was purchased and settled by Thomas Macy in 1659 as a protest for a heavy fine levied by his Puritan Church for helping some Quakers during a storm. *(Please remember to wear comfortable walking shoes for the cobblestone streets and brick sidewalks that line Nantucket's downtown area.)* Return to the mainland on the 2:15 pm ferry. Arrive at your resort to enjoy the amenities and have dinner on your own.
- Day 7** Enjoy an early breakfast at the resort, then check out and bid farewell to Cape Cod as you travel to your overnight hotel for lodging *(pack an overnight bag)*; dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 8** After breakfast, check out and depart for home with lasting memories of your trip to Cape Cod and Newport, RI.
